## Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

*Entrance Antiphon:* **Within your temple, we ponder your loving kindness, O God. As your name, so also your praise reaches to the ends of earth; your right hand is filled with justice.**

***A reading from the book of the prophet Ezekiel 2.2-5***

The heavens were opened, and I saw visions of God. When I saw this, I fell on my face, and I heard the voice of someone speaking.

When the voice spoke to me, a spirit entered into me and set me on my feet; and I heard one speaking to me: "Mortal, I am sending you to the people of Israel, to a nation of rebels who have rebelled against me; The descendants are impudent and stubborn. I am sending you to them, and you shall say to them, 'Thus says the Lord God.' Whether they hear or refuse to hear (for they are a rebellious house), they shall know that there has been a prophet among them."

R. Our eyes are fixed on the Lord, pleading for his mercy

Lord, I look up to you, up to heaven, where you rule. R.

As a servant depends on his master, as a maid depends on her mistress, so we will keep looking to you, O Lord our God, until you have mercy on us. R.

Be merciful to us, Lord, be merciful: we have been treated with so much contempt. R.

We have been mocked too long by the rich and scorned by proud oppressors. R.

***A reading from the second letter of Paul to the Corinthians 12.7-10***

Considering the exceptional character of the revelations, to keep me from being too elated, a thorn was given me in the flesh, a messenger of Satan to torment me, to keep me from being too elated.

Three times I appealed to the Lord about this, that it would leave me, but he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for power is made perfect in weakness." So, I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may dwell in me.

Therefore I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and calamities for the sake of Christ; for whenever I am weak, then I am strong.
